Region

The biggest and most important of Argentina's wine regions, Mendoza includes a wide variety of altitudes and micro-climates to allow a huge range of wine styles. Many early winemakers were of Italian origin and brought with them their native Barbera, Bonarda and Sangiovese. However, it is Malbec, originally from Bordeaux and the south west of France, that has established the most successful presence in Mendoza.

Producer

These wines have been specifically chosen for Ellis by our team of buyers. The focus of this range is to create high quality wines which capture the quintessential characteristics of varieties from around the winemaking world.

Tasting Notes

This organically grown Malbec, currently in its final year of conversion, is grown in the vineyards of Mendoza. A dark purple in colour with bramble fruits and black cherries on the nose. The palate has great concentration with velvety texture, dark fruits and chocolate on the finish.
